Device Distribution and Troubleshooting

Homeroom teachers will assign and distribute a numbered device and charger to each student from the classroom cart. Each will include the device number and cart number. Both devices will be placed in a large ziploc bag.

- Students in grades K-5 will be assigned a device to use for classroom instruction that will remain at school. K-5 devices will only be sent home in the event of an extended closure.
- Students in grades 6-8 will take the assigned Chromebook and charger home each day to use and charge as necessary.

Delivery of Instruction & Monitoring of Student Learning

Google Classroom will be the learning platform used for the delivery of instruction and to monitor student learning. Teachers will post student assignments to be completed in Google Classroom and will provide feedback to students weekly.

All teachers will be available daily during school hours and will hold a Google Meets session at least once per week with each class. Teachers will share contact information with parents and students. Communication can be made through either Class Dojo, email, or Google Classroom.

Pre-K

Students will read or participate in a read aloud 15-20 minutes per day.

Students will complete a 15-20 minute math lesson each day.

Students will select 2 additional lessons from the choice board to complete each day.

Assignments will be posted within Google Classroom by 9:00am on Monday morning for the week.

PreK teachers will use Class Dojo to communicate with parents and students.

K-2

Students will read for 20 minutes each day or participate in a read-aloud.

Students will complete a math lesson each day by accessing an online learning platform or completing an assignment from the Eureka workbook.

Students will then select 2 additional assignments from the choice board each day. Weekly assignments will be posted each Monday by 9:00 a.m.

3-5

Students will use Google Classroom to access and complete the digital content in their assigned courses. Students will go through the assigned lessons to complete each day's work.
