# COVID-19 INFO HOW CONTACT TRACING WORKS

After a person receives a positive test result for COVID-19, contact tracing protocols are enacted. All "close contacts" of the individual are notified and required to quarantine for 14 days at home.

Stay Safe!

### 01

Department of Public Health defines "close contacts" as individuals who were less than six feet away from the person for a total of 15 minutes or more during the 48 hours prior to symptom(s) occurring.

### 02

This means passing someone in the hallway does not necessarily make you a "close contact". It is important to socially distance as much as possible because you will be required to stay at home if you are identified as a "close contact".

## 03

At CCS, we are using assigned seats in our classrooms to expedite contact tracing.

#### WAYS YOU CAN HELP ENSURE WE STAY IN SCHOOL

- Mask up when social distancing is not possible
- Wash your hands frequently with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or use hand sanitizer.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
