Digital Learning Days

What are digital learning days?

Digital learning days occur when students are not present at school due to weather and other situations where Chattooga County Schools are closed.

How will it work for students?

- On the day that schools have been canceled, teachers will post assignments to Chattooga County Schools Google Classroom that will enrich or remediate students.
- That link can be accessed via <https://clever.com/> and then Google Classroom. Each student will have assignments for their classes. Assignments could be cross-curricular where teachers and grade level teams assign an activity together.
- Students will need a class code to see assignments. These will also be posted within Clever. Students have to login with their studentfirstname.lastname@chattoogaschools.org email to get the class codes list and to join the classes.
- All assignments will be posted in Google Classroom no later than 9:00 AM the morning school has been canceled.

How can my student get help if needed?

- Teachers will be available and will instruct students on the best way to contact them. Designated contact times will be as follows:

Elementary Grades	9:00 AM – 10:00 AM 1:00 PM – 2:00 PM
Middle/High Grades	10:00 AM – 11:00 AM 2:00 PM – 3:00 PM

What if my student does not have internet access or other technical issues?

- If this happens teachers will adjust due dates for Digital Learning Day assignments as necessary for their students. Students will also be granted 6 days to complete the assignments from the day school resumes.
- If parents do not have Internet access or are having technical difficulties, student packets will be available at each school office for pick up each Tuesday & Thursday from 9:00-11:00 and 1:00-3:00 or arrangements can be made by contacting your school principal at each school.
