CCS COVID-19 Weekly Status Report

All positive COVID-19 cases in CCS will be tracked per school and reported to GaDPH. A rise in case levels will result in a shift to a new scenario at that school for the following week to allow for contact tracing and increased sanitation. Percentages of positive cases will be based on the individual total school population which will include all staff and students. Positive cases will be tabulated weekly. The Superintendent will issue a status report to the public for each school every Friday at 4:30 p.m. so parents can make any necessary childcare arrangements for the following week.

*GaDPH retains the authority to close schools based on COVID-19 community spread and hospitalization rate.



COVID-19 Weekly Scenarios for Individual CCS Schools

All students and visitors will be subject to health screenings.

ON CAMPUS

COVID-19 Risk Level: Low to No Spread

Less than 2% of the individual school population with confirmed cases.

Every student participating in traditional learning comes to school five days a week on a regular schedule. Visitors restricted to scheduled meetings only and essential personnel.

HYBRID PATH 1

COVID-19 Risk Level: Minimal

2% of the individual school population with confirmed cases.

Every student participating in traditional learning comes to school four days a week, Tuesday-Friday, on a regular schedule. Monday is used for distance learning and teacher planning while schools receive a deep cleaning.

HYBRID PATH 2

COVID-19 Risk Level: Moderate

3% of the individual school population with confirmed cases.

Every student participating in traditional learning comes to school two days a week, Tuesday-Friday, on every other day schedule so half the students are present. Monday is used for distance learning and teacher planning while schools receive a deep cleaning.

DISTANCE LEARNING COVID-19 Risk Level: Substantial Spread

4% or greater of the individual school population with confirmed cases.

Every student participating in traditional learning will learn from home five days a week.
