Summer Feeding Program Information

Chattooga County School Nutrition is pleased to announce the Summer Feeding Program will operate again this year. This program allows meals to all children under 18, free of charge. The Summer Feeding Program will run from June 6th until July 22nd. We will not have any meal service during the week of July 4 - 8, in observance of the July 4th Holiday. We take extra precautions to keep our community, staff, and children safe. Therefore, we will have sites available where you may pick up meals for any child under the age of 18. Children do not have to be present to receive a meal. Meals will be available at the following sites:

Chattooga High School- will provide five days of breakfast and five days of lunch. Our first pick-up date will be Tuesday, June 7th. After that, meal pick-up will be available on Monday each week through July 18th. Meal pick-up will be between 11 AM and 1 PM.

Fairway Recreation Center- lunch will be provided Monday-Friday from June 6th-July 22nd. Meal service will be 11:40 AM to 1:40 PM, or until all meals are gone. (No meal service July 4th-8th)

Fields Walk Mobile Home Park- A school bus will be used to bring five days of breakfast and five days of lunch to children in this area. Our first drop-off date will be Tuesday, June 7th. After that, meal drop-off will be on Monday each week through July 18th. Delivery will begin at 11:15 AM until meals are gone.

East Trion Church of God-365 First Street, Trion, GA 30753--A school bus will be used to bring five days of breakfast and five days of lunch to children in this area. Our first drop-off date will be Tuesday, June 7th. After that, meal drop-off will be on Monday each week through July 18th. Delivery will begin at 12:00 PM until meals are gone.
