Chattooga County Schools: Leroy Massey Elementary School Distance Learning Plan: Extended Closure

Purpose and School Information

In the event of extended school closure (2 weeks or more), the Chattooga County School System will follow the Extended Closure Distance Learning Plan. The following plan contains specific information for Leroy Massey Elementary School.

Device Distribution and Troubleshooting

- Each Chromebook/Ipad will be assigned to a specific student in the first week of school(21-22) using the Technology Distribution Form.
- Records of the assignment will be kept by the classroom teacher, administrator, and academic coach.
- Student name, cart #, and the school Chromebook number will be placed on each charger.
- Chromebook and charger will be placed in a 2-gallon zip lock bag to be sent home.
 Student name, cart #, and the school Chromebook number will be placed on each ziplock bag.
- If students have issues with their device, they should complete a student device support ticket (will include contact number) to report the problem. A technology support member will contact the student/parent concerning the issue and will schedule a drop off time if needed to repair. Technical support is located at 286 Maple Drive, Summerville. Times will be posted.
- Students in grades K-5 will be assigned a Chromebook to utilize in classroom instruction at school. The devices will not be sent home unless requested or in the case of an extended school closure.

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Delivery of Instruction & Monitoring of Student Learning

All grade-level assignments will be accessible through Google Classroom. Google Classroom will be the source of any new instruction and the monitoring of student learning. Assignments will be posted in the google classroom for the students to complete and teacher feedback will be provided weekly. Students and parents may communicate with teachers through email, Google Classroom, Class Dojo, or by calling the student's school and leaving a message.

PreK

Students will read for 15-20 minutes or participate in a read-aloud each day.

Students will complete a 15-20 minute math lesson each day.

Students will select 2 additional lessons from the choice board each day.

PreK teachers will use Class Dojo to communicate with parents and students.

Assignments will be posted within Google Classroom by 9:00 am on Monday morning for the week.

K-2

Students will participate in a live reading lesson three times per week and complete work related to the lesson.

Students will participate in a live math lesson three times per week and complete work related to the lesson.

On Fridays, PE, Art, and Music will host live meetings.

Students will then select two assignments from the choice board each day.

Assignments for the week will be posted by Monday at 9:00 a.m.

3-5

Students will use Google Classroom to access and complete digital content in their assigned courses. Students will go through the assigned lesson to complete the day's work. Monday-Thursday: ELA (Reading and Writing), Math, Science & Social Studies, and Friday-Connections/Specials (PE, Art, & Music).

Students will participate in a live reading lesson three times per week and complete work related to the lesson.

Students will participate in a live math lesson three times per week and complete work related to the lesson.

On Fridays, PE, Art, and Music will host live meetings.

Assignments for the week will be posted by Monday at 9:00 a.m.
